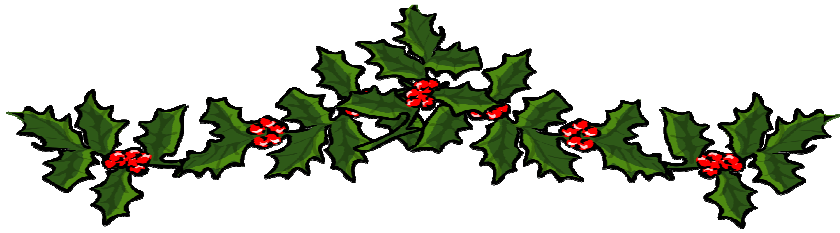

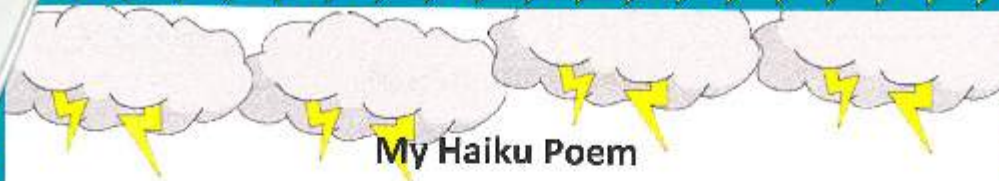

2016 PARENT PAYMENT CHARGES

Dear Parents/Guardians

To continue the high level of education provided at Wattleview Primary School, our School Council has carefully assessed student needs in regard to the Essential Education Items.

The Education and Training Reform Act 2006 provides that instruction in the standard curriculum program is delivered free to all students in Victorian Government Schools - this is referred to as 'free instruction'. The Act also grants school councils the power to charge fees for goods and services to support the delivery of free instruction and to raise funds.

There are two areas for which parents are requested to make a payment or contribution.

Essential Education Items: This covers the cost of their child's items such as books, stationery, exercise books, art supplies, Mathematics, Literacy Planet and other curriculum requirements.

Optional Education Items: These are offered on a user pay basis and parents/guardians may choose whether their child accesses or participates in, eg. camps, swimming, graduations, instruction music etc.

The School provides a service whereby the stationery needs of children are bought in boxes and distributed to your child on collection day. This enables the school to provide the supplies at a significantly reduced price to parents and it also means that all children have the correct requirements for their year level. Although children are supplied with what is considered sufficient materials for the entire year, further purchases during the year are usually required. It is expected that stationery will be purchased through the school.

The following charges of **\$320 per student** have been endorsed by School Council on 25 November 2015.

The essential education items are broken down into the following components:-

- All boxed and bulk supplies	\$140.00
- Art Materials	\$40.00
- ICT Levy - this includes printing, Mathematics and Literacy Planet access	\$140.00

Collection:

Collection and payment of your student materials will be held on **Wednesday 27th January 2016** from 9am at the school office

THERE ARE 3 OPTIONS FOR PAYMENT OF FEES

Option 1 - Full Payment due on **Wednesday 27th January 2016**

Option 2 - Deposit with Full Payment

Deposit of \$140 due on **Wednesday 27th January 2016**. Balance of the Essential Education Items by **Friday 26th February 2016**.


Options 3 - Deposit with 4 Monthly Instalments


Deposit of \$140 due on **Wednesday 27th January 2016** and 4 equal monthly instalments of \$45.00

Instalments are due on **15 February, 15 March, 15 April, 15 May** or until all fees are paid in full.

Payment methods offered in 2016 will include cash, efpos, credit card and internet banking
