



WATTLEVIEW PRIMARY SCHOOL CURRICULUM POLICY

1. Rationale

Victorian Curriculum is the Foundation to Year 10 curriculum that provides a single, coherent and comprehensive set of prescribed content and common achievement standards, which schools use to plan student learning programs, assess student progress and report to parents.

Implementation of The Victorian Curriculum across the school will provide all students with a sequential curriculum framework that guides their learning, as well as providing measures of learning achievement that follow students, giving teachers the opportunity to assess student performance against standardised learning outcomes.

2. Aims

To improve student learning through the implementation of The Victorian Curriculum, and across all year levels in a manner consistent with departmental requirements and locally identified needs.

3. Implementation:

The school is committed to the implementation of the Victorian Curriculum across Strands and Domains, to all year levels.

School Council will have an active Education Committee in order to oversee curriculum direction and implementation across the school. The School Improvement Team will be allocated the responsibility for coordination and implementation of curriculum.

In doing so, all Department of Education and Training (DET) timelines and reporting requirements must be met.

Whole school professional learning opportunities will be provided to staff through Professional Learning Forums.

All staff members have access to The Victorian Curriculum information online and are required to work with their respective teams in the development and implementation of a curriculum that responds to individual student needs.

Student achievement will be measured and reported to students, parents, DET and the wider community against The Victorian Curriculum achievement levels.

All staff will participate in the collection of student achievement data. All staff will have input into school direction decisions resulting from interpretations of student achievement data.

Evaluation

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's three year cycle or as needed to comply with DET policy changes.
