

2021 PARENT PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

Dear Parents / Guardians,

Wattle View Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of Wattle View's parent payment arrangements for 2021.

Wattle View Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents. In doing this we have been able to reduce our fees.

On an annual basis School Council prepares a budget to provide resources for educational programs, administration, facilities development and maintenance.

There are three areas for which parents are requested to make a payment or contribution. These include:-

Essential Student Learning Items: This covers the cost of your child's items such as books, stationery, curriculum supplies and digital technologies.

Optional Items: These are offered on a user pay basis and parents/guardians may choose whether their child accesses or participates in, EG: Camp program, excursions, graduations etc. The Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund is available to recipients of a pension or health care card to assist with expenses in this area.

Voluntary Contributions: Wattle View Primary School welcome any voluntary contributions.

Payment Methods offered include: Cash, Eftpos / Credit Card, Internet Banking and Centrepay. Please note that Centrepay is only available to Services Australia recipients.

The School provides a service whereby the stationery needs of children are bought in packs and distributed to your child on collection day. This enables the school to provide the supplies at a significantly reduced price to parents and it also means that all children have the correct requirements for their year level. Although children are supplied with what is considered sufficient materials for the entire year, further purchases by the school during the year are usually required. It is expected that stationery will be purchased through the school.

2021 Essential Student Learning Items

Essential student learning items are those items which students take temporary or permanent possession of. These items are detailed below and consist of an individual book pack, consumable items per curriculum areas and Online learning subscriptions. *Note: prices do not include GST.*Parents may choose to purchase a **book pack** through the school or provide your own. If you wish to purchase your own, please contact the office for a list of items by **Friday 13th November 2020. PLEASE NOTE** – if you decide to purchase the items in the book pack yourself, you will still be required to pay the balance in relation to curriculum consumables and on line learning as detailed below.

Excursions/Incursions - costs to be paid throughout the year

Parents/Carers will pay and provide permission for excursions/incursions as they arise.

CSEF (Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund)

Families holding a valid means-tested concession card or temporary foster parents are eligible for CSEF payments. Applications for the CSEF will be available from the school office. Payments are made directly to the school and are attached to individual students.
